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Another Brush Tool is the Paint Bucket tool. It is used to paint large areas of pixels, such as white areas. Photoshop has a lot of different Paint Bucket tools for various purposes.

Bucket Fill allows you to fill an image with a specific color, gradient,

or pattern. Text Tool is used to add text to an image. It is a good option to create an author name and article title, such as “The Birth of Photoshop.” The words are easy to edit. You can change font, color, alignment, and more. A Lasso tool lets you draw a straight line and a rectangular

selection. Use it to clip an image, select certain objects, or round and edit an object. The Blob Brush lets you choose color and brushes to fill the area. Use it to create new logos, websites, and other types of logos. Paint Bucket is used to create complicated shapes. It is also used to create complicated

effects such as painting.
